Enjoying the Outdoors Safely

In respect for public safety, D&R Greenway is monitoring best practices during the pandemic, and maintaining open trails with support from local communities.

We respectfully ask that you follow social distancing guidelines:
6'-10' distance between you and anyone outside of your household.

We recognize the importance of daily exercise and natural surroundings, especially now. You have told us you value walking on our trails for well-being. Our goal is to keep our open spaces and trails open and protect everyone.

THESE TRAILS ARE OPEN AND ACCESSIBLE:

In Hopewell and Pennington:

- ❑ St. Michaels Farm Preserve (all trails) from Princeton Avenue and Aunt Molly Road
- ❑ Cedar Ridge Preserve from Stony Brook and Van Dyke roads
- ❑ The Sourlands Ecosystem Preserve D&R Greenway trailheads on Mountain Road and Featherbed Lane
- ❑ Penn View Heights (from Kunkel Park) in Pennington
- ❑ Hopewell Connector Trail above Hopewell borough
- ❑ Woosamonsa Ridge Preserve – there is limited pedestrian access until Hopewell Township completes the parking area to be built on Woosamonsa Road; please do not park on private properties
